## NO PASS, NO PLAY GUIDELINES HELP SHEET

THIS SHEET IS INTENDED TO HELP YOU UNDERSTAND THE GUIDELINES OF THE UIL/TEA "NO PASS, NO PLAY" ELIGIBILITY POLICY. THIS POLICY IS USED FOR ALL UIL ACTIVITIES IN MIDDLE SCHOOL, AND THE FINE ARTS DEPARTMENTS ALSO UTILIZE THESE GUIDELINES FOR ELEGIBILITY FOR ATTENDING OUR FIESTA TEXAS PERFORMANCE TRIPS. THIS REQUIRES STUDENTS TO PASS ALL CLASSES IN ORDER TO TRAVEL WITH, COMPETE WITH, AND PARTICPATE IN EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITES OUTSIDE OF THE CLASSROOM. (SCHOOL CONCERTS ON CAMPUS ARE CONSIDERED EXTENSIONS OF THE CLASSROOM AND DO NOT APPLY). THE STUDENTS HAVE BEEN MADE AWARE OF THIS POLICY, AND WE GIVE THEM FREQUENT REMINDERS TO KEEP UP WITH THEIR GRADES. THIS INFORMATION IS ALSO MENTIONED IN OUR SYLLABUS, DISTRIBUTED AT THE BEGINNING OF THE SCHOOL YEAR. BELOW ARE SOME HIGHLIGHTS OF PARTICULAR IMPORTANCE.

- ELIGIBILTY GRADE CHECKS HAPPEN AFTER THE FIRST 6 WEEKS OF SCHOOL, AND EVERY 3 WEEKS
  AFTER THAT.
- STUDENTS LOSE ELIGIBILITY IF THEY FAIL (69 OR BELOW) ANY CLASS ON A REPORT CARD.
- STUDENTS CAN REGAIN ELIGIBILITY BY PASSING ALL CLASSES ON A PROGRESS REPORT
- A PROGRESS REPORT CANNOT MAKE A STUDENT INELIGIBILE, BUT CAN HELP A STUDENT REGAIN ELIGIBILITY
- THERE IS A GRACE PERIOD OF ONE WEEK FOLLOWING EACH ELIGIBILITY CHECK
- STUDENTS WHO PASSED EVERY CLASS ON THE THIRD NINE WEEKS REPORT CARD ARE ELIGIBLE FOR THE REST OF THE SCHOOL YEAR
- STUDENTS WHO FAILED A CLASS ON THE 3<sup>RD</sup> 9 WEEKS REPORT CARD WILL HAVE TWO CHANCES TO REGAIN ELIGIBILITY. THERE WILL BE A GRADE CHECK AGAIN ON APRIL 8<sup>TH</sup> AND APRIL 29<sup>TH</sup> (REGAIN ELIGIBILITY MAY 1<sup>ST</sup>, END OF SCHOOL DAY)
- A STUDENTS GRADE THE DAY OF OR THE DAY BEFORE A TRIP/COMPETITION DO NOT FACTOR INTO ELIGIBILITY STATUS. ELIGIBILITY IS BASED ON THE REPORT CARD AND GRADE CHECK DATES ABOVE.
- THE DIRECTORS AND/OR ADMINISTRATION HAVE THE RIGHT TO KEEP A STUDENT AT SCHOOL FOR ANY REASON THEY DEEM NECESSARY INCLUDING BEHAVIOUR AND CURRENT ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE.
