BEGINNING BAND INFO

Hello and welcome to the band program! We are glad that your student has decided to participate in the Band at BMSN. We hope that your child enjoys learning to play a musical instrument. The following is a list of supplies that your child needs to participate in the band program. A list of recommended brands of instruments and required supplies is on the back of this sheet. Keep in mind that quality USED instruments are great for beginners!

Instruments: Students will furnish their own instruments *unless they are assigned to play Oboe, Bassoon, Bass Clarinet, French Horn, Baritone or Tuba*. Students playing french horn, baritone, or tuba will need to **supply their own mouthpiece and accessories**, as well as pay a \$80/year school-instrument rental fee. Students playing bass clarinet, oboe, or bassoon will need to **supply their own reeds and accessories**, as well as pay a \$80/year school-instrument rental fee (paid by Oct 1st). The fee covers expenses for normal maintenance and up-keep of the horns. Students are responsible for any other additional costs from accidental damage and loss. Assistance may be available for any student who is unable to provide the required materials. We strive to ensure that financial situations do not have any bearing on student's ability to participate in band.

Most music stores have a rental-purchase plan, cash discounts, etc. There are several dealers in the Boerne/San Antonio area. If you are considering purchasing from another source, you are encouraged to contact a band director before doing so. Please be careful to pick a store that can give full service. A list of several local music stores is below.

We recommend brand name instruments that have a good history of reliability and readily available repair parts. Many "inexpensive" instruments can be found through online retailers and auction sites, but there is no support or repair parts available. Craigslist and other local marketplace websites are often a great place to find good quality used instruments. Feel free to email us a link to any instruments you would like a professional opinion of.
