Sectionals (Symphonic and Honors Band Only)

Sectionals are very important to developing musicians, as we are not able to see every student every day. Sectionals give the opportunity for more individualized help based on the needs of the students and the instrument they play. Sectionals will be scheduled in the Fall for Region Band Audition Music and in the Spring for UIL Contest Selections.

Beginning Purple and Grey Band

All beginner band students will be divided into either the purple or grey band. These groups will be formed so the beginners can practice together as a full band (we cannot fit all of them in the band hall at the same time). These groups will meet once a week during study hall. This will begin early October. Please make sure your student brings their instrument to school that day (as they may not have regular band class that day).

Practice/Instruments

Practice is a very important part of becoming a good young musician. Instruments should be taken home after school after being used in class. It is very important for students to play at home, especially on the days they do not have band class. Please encourage practice at home by asking students to "play a song for me" or "what is your next playing test over." Thank you for facilitating practice at home.

Private Lessons

We believe private lessons are a major factor in the development of all musicians at every skill level, from beginner to professional. In an effort to make lessons most accessible, students are allowed/encouraged to take lessons during band class. They may also schedule lessons before and after school. Lessons are usually for 30 minutes, at a rate of \$20-\$25 per lesson, depending on the instructor. This rate is based upon our instructors being degreed and extremely proficient in their area of expertise. The private lesson instructors can focus on the individual needs of the students and help them excel. This is especially helpful for those students planning on auditioning for all region bands. Private lessons are also a great way for a beginning band student to get more individualized help to build a strong musical foundation. The instructors that have been selected to work with our students are some of the best in Texas, with incredible experience and resumes. Please refer to the Private Lesson Instructor Contact letter for more details and contact information for our lesson staff. **We look forward to rebuilding our private lesson program after a year and a half of not having private instructors able to come onto campus. Band Shirts/Uniforms

FOR ALL BAND MEMBERS: Our band T-shirts are in the making for this year and are required of all members. These shirts are used for informal performances. The shirt normally costs less than \$10. More information will be available when the artists finish the design. There is a possibility that our shirts will be donated by a sponsor this year. Are you interested in sponsoring our shirts?!? **FOR SYMPHONIC AND HONORS BAND ONLY**: Our formal band uniform consists of our black band polo (same every year, 8th graders do not need to purchase a new one). This is worn with khaki slacks and black belt, black shoes, and black socks. Polo's should be tucked in. The polos usually run about \$20 dollars.

Jazz Band and Drum and Fife

We offer the opportunity for our students to participate in a jazz band and Drum and Fife Corps program. This is an afterschool "club" situation and is at no extra cost to the student. Jazz is geared towards more advanced players and drum and fife is offered to any of our members. Be on the lookout for more information, as our normal schedules have changed with the pandemic.
